


validation. Ever the English teacher, Ms. Marceaux believes the earlier you teach children language precision, the better it will help them succeed in their future relationships and careers.

come face to face with the weirdest, most peculiar situation ever: **Dancing Chickens!** This book is about Wurstfest, the German celebration.



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
